International Director

Position Summary:

Assists and promote the understanding of global and international HR at the chapter and state level. Works to further the interests of the state council. Provides a forum for members to participate in meetings, workshops, and VA SHRM/SHRM events of interest to the international and domestic HR communities.

Responsibilities:

- Serve as a voting member of the state council and is expected to attend and participate in all meetings of the council.
- Submit relevant articles for the state council magazine.
- Serve as advocate for international HR on state council and at other professional meetings and assist chapters in coordinating programs and activities on global HR interests.
- Identify and evaluate international issues which impact workplaces and develop goals for state council strategy.
- Provide reports on issues to state council members and serve as advocate at state council activities for international programs.
- Serve as a resource for state council on international HR issues and provide awareness and leadership to the chapters on these issues.
- Work with the SHRM staff liaison on international issues.
- Develop and support workshops and seminars which address international HR topics and issues.
- Respond to any other requirements of the state council president.

Requirements:

- Must be an SHRM member in good standing. HRCI and/or SHRM certification highly desirable.
- Serves a two year term beginning the first day of January and ending the last day of December.
